Steve Meurer is UHC's Senior Vice President for Comparative Data and Informatics. In this role, Dr. Meurer is responsible for Information Technology and a substantial portion of UHC's data products, including the Operational Data Base, the core measures intermediary services, Resource Manager, and the Clinical Data Base, all of which provides transparent, comparative data to hospitals for performance improvement and research. Dr. Meurer and his team provide the management of these products as well as training and analysis support assistance to subscribers

for the improvement of performance.

Dr. Meurer has been with UHC since April of 2007. Prior to this, his background included 15 years of healthcare administration experience, including the Chief Quality & Information Officer at the DeKalb Regional Healthcare System in Atlanta, and the Vice President of Operations and Performance Improvement at St. Mary's Medical Center in Langhorne, Pennsylvania. Dr. Meurer has spent time in increasing roles of responsibility at a number of organizations, including the Orlando Regional Healthcare System, University Pittsburgh Healthcare System and BJC Healthcare. In addition, Dr. Meurer has taught quality to Masters students at Loyola (Chicago), Rush, Georgia Tech, Georgia State, and Temple.

Dr. Meurer received a PhD in health services outcomes research from St. Louis University, master's degrees in business administration and health science from the University of Florida, and a bachelor's degree in psychology from the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, Mass. He also holds a certificate in health care quality and informatics.
