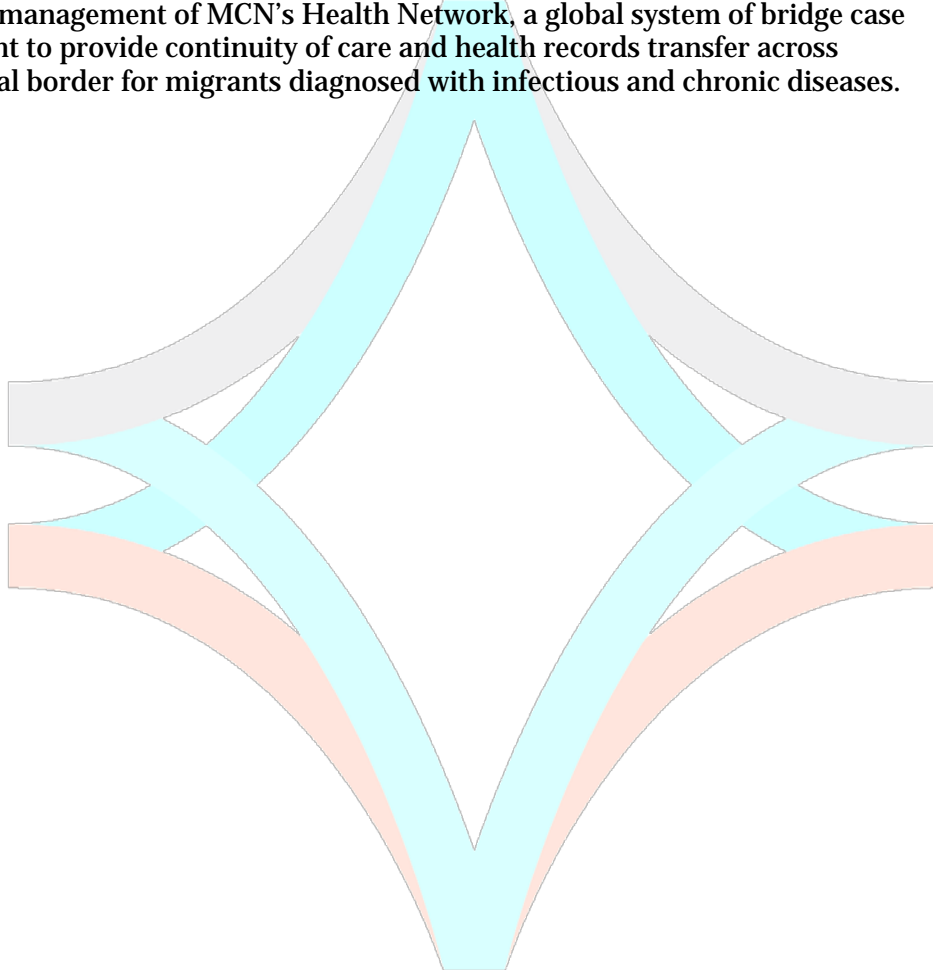


Deliana Garcia

Susan Perez is an assistant professor at California State University, Sacramento. Her research focuses on understanding individual decision-making processes in order to develop healthcare policies, information, and resources to promote high value decisions. Dr. Perez has conducted studies that classified approaches to processing internet health information among vulnerable populations; addressed statewide overuse of healthcare services; identified approaches for patients and providers to discuss the cost of care; developed a statewide campaign to address variations in C-section rates by working with both patients and hospitals; and illuminated consumers' views of cost sharing, quality, and network choice. Prior to her appointment at California State University, Sacramento, Dr. Perez completed a postdoctoral fellowship in quality, safety, and comparative effectiveness research and earned a doctorate in Nursing Science and Health-Care Leadership program at the University of California, Davis.
